"Earth doesn't belong to us, we belong to earth."

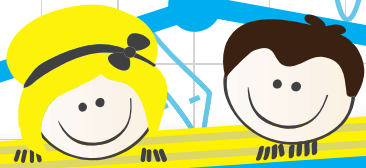

# Earth Day Celebration





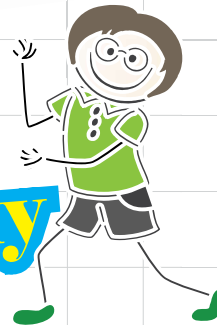
Students of classes 1-9 & 11th were awarded prizes for their exceptional achievement in academics for the session 2016-17.

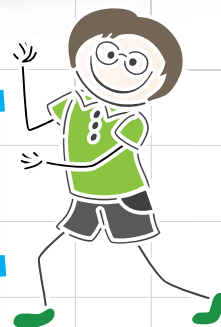

# Labour Day Celebration

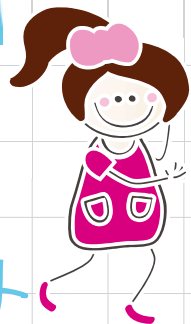
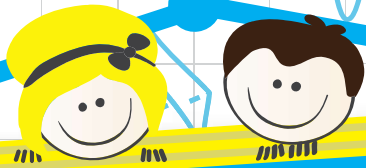
