

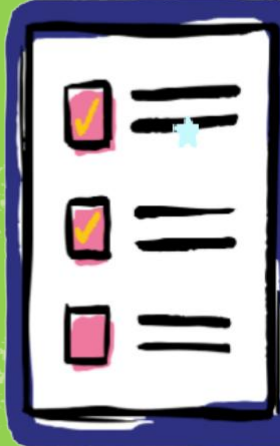

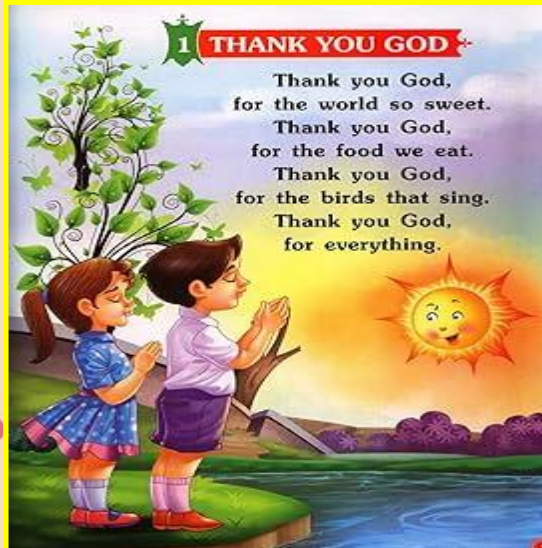

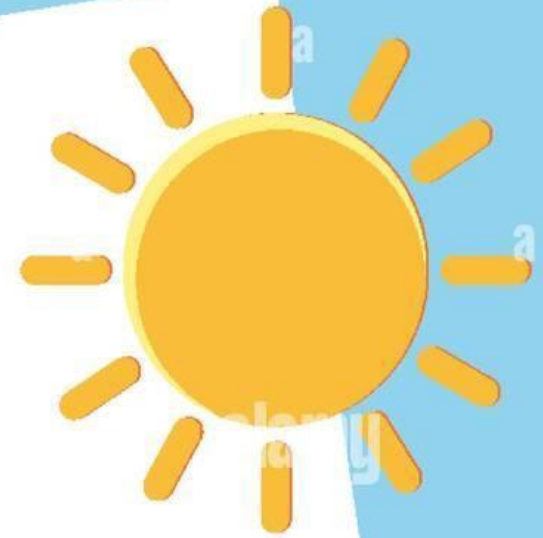

And fluffy tail.

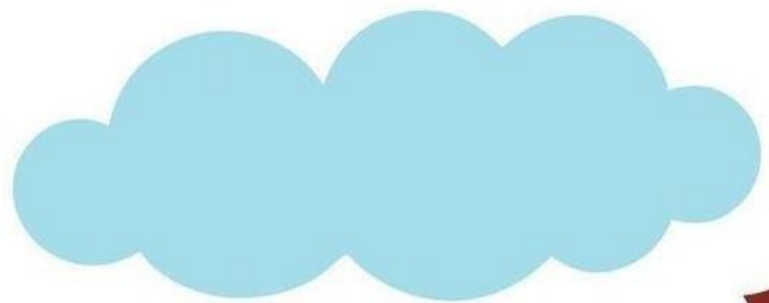


### Domestic Animals
